In chamber music, musicians need to know what others are playing and do their best to

enhance it. This can involve softening their own part so that the primary melody is clearly heard. It can sometimes also involve subtly changing the tempo before someone else's hard part, so that the other person can play their part convincingly, making the overall performance much more solid. There are other possibilities here as well.
